We are seeking an experienced casual / part time Nature Guide / Keeper to:

- * help run and maintain day-to-day the Unzoo's highly rated visitor and wildlife operations,
- * work to help save endangered Tasmanian devils in the wild.

The position

These are casual positions

You will require a well documented ability

- to work with a family business
 to take responsibility in a small team
- to play an all-round hands-on role in providing entertaining visitor experiences, high quality native animal management and first class maintenance

Location

For part time this will suit a Hobart based person prepared to spend two or three nights a week staying in the South East area.

The primary location of this position is at Tasmanian Devil Unzoo on Tasman Peninsula in South East Tasmania, about an hour from Hobart, however this position may require you to work at various locations.

Duties

Your duties will be based around the Unzoo's mission to embrace and interpret the local wild birds, marsupials and extensive native flora.

Regular visitor presentations are the key part of this position.

Additional duties will include taking tours, food preparation, cleaning, ground maintenance with mowers and trimmers, ticket sales and monitoring wild Tasmanian devils.

This is an outdoor role with the following criteria

- A dependable record as a nature guide / wildlife keeper
 Willingness to take responsibility to ensure visitor and animal activities run reliably
- · Demonstrated ability to provide professional presentations for visitors
- A good knowledge and understanding of native fauna and flora
 Experience in working with animals for public presentations
- · High standard of personal presentation
- Experience with wildlife management Cert 3 in Wildlife Management an advantage
 4WD driving experience and a public passenger vehicle licence an advantage
- · Willingness to comply with workplace policies and standards
- Fitness and ability to handle and carry loads up to 15 kg and to stand for long periods
- · Current manual driver's licence, current first aid certificate

Background

Tasmanian Devil Unzoo is an innovative nature centre showcasing Tasmania's native plants and animals.

It offers a very high quality visitor experience in recognition of which the Unzoo has received a TripAdvisor Certificate of Excellence for the past four years and currently is rating over 4.5 stars in TripAdvisor reviews.

The successful applicant will be expected to maintain and build on this very high standard.

As a small private run family operation Tasmanian Devil Unzoo originally was established as the world's first Tasmanian devil centre about an hour from Hobart on Tasman Peninsula in Tasmania's South East.

In recent years it has been developed under a ground breaking Unzoo master plan by renowned designer Jon Coe which embraces the surrounding natural world as well as the park inhabitants.

This includes a large native botanic garden, wild Devil Tracker tours, bird tours and nature photography. Interestingly the boundary fence has been removed so local wild animals can come and go as they wish.

The Unzoo is the major partner in the Peninsula Devil Conservation Project which aims to preserve the last secure natural population of devils on Tasman and Forestier Peninsulas.

The Unzoo's Save the Devil effort includes monitoring wild devils with remote cameras and raising funds for electronic roadside alarms to reduce road kill.
